Challenging (maximum program time) - 33

This exciting short trek itinerary begins with experiencing western life at the original Rocky Mountain Scout Camp — the beginning camp of what is now Philmont. You will then head to Pueblano where you can climb spar poles (what's on the top of them anyway?), make railroad ties, and watch one of most popular evening programs at Philmont. After that, you will climb to the top of 12,441' Baldy Mt. where you feel like you can see the whole world! The challenge events at Head of Dean will test your crew skills as you work together to solve problems. Finish your trek with some of Philmont's most exciting rock climbing at Dean Cow then wrap everything up with the closing awards campfire when you return to base camp.
